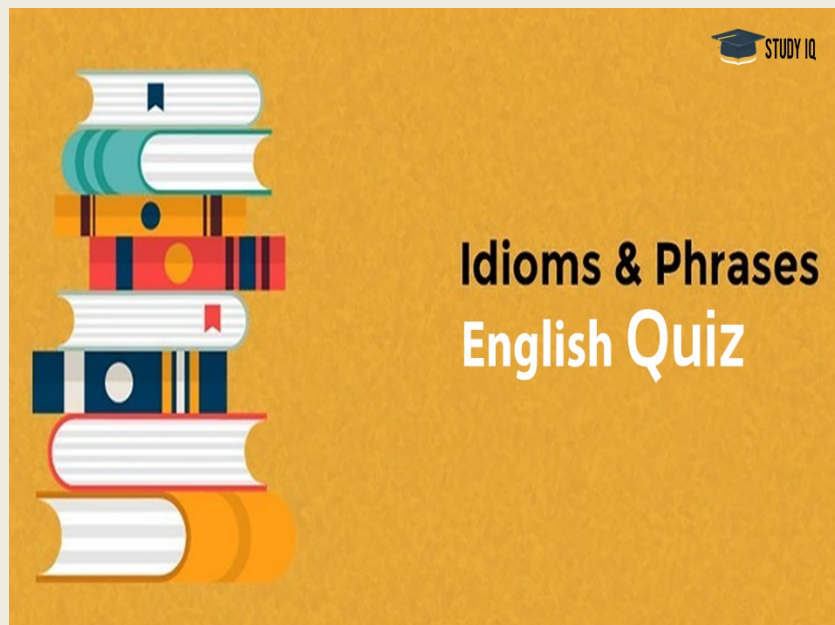

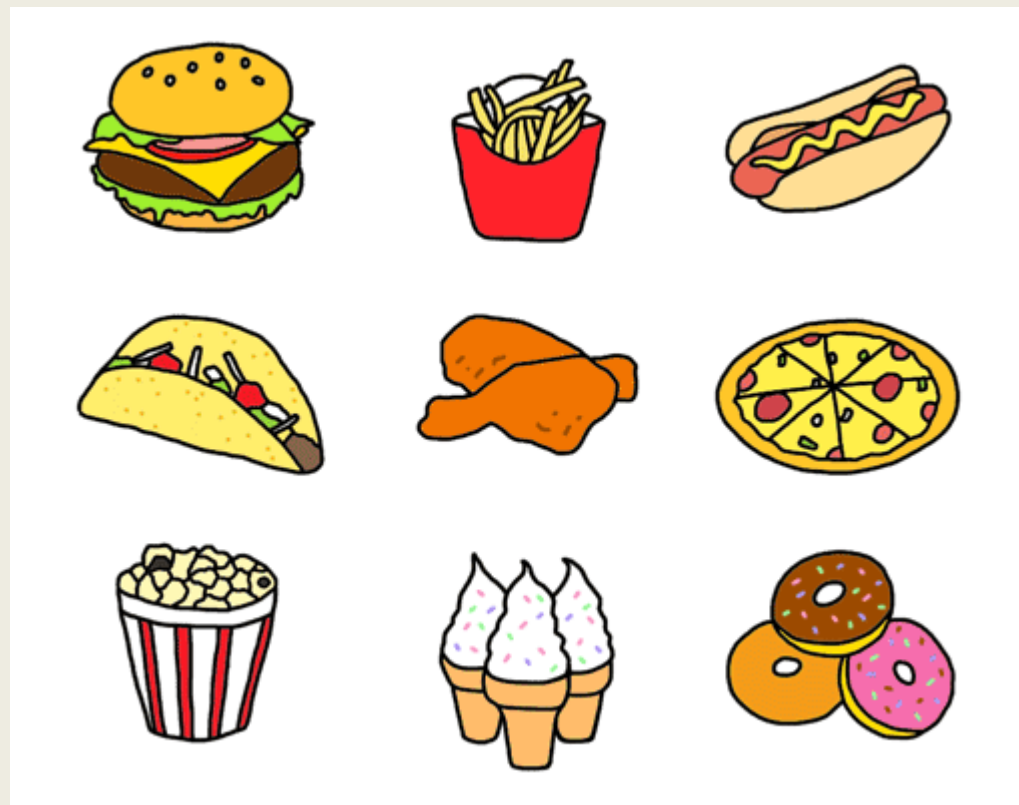

For example — «As easy as pie»

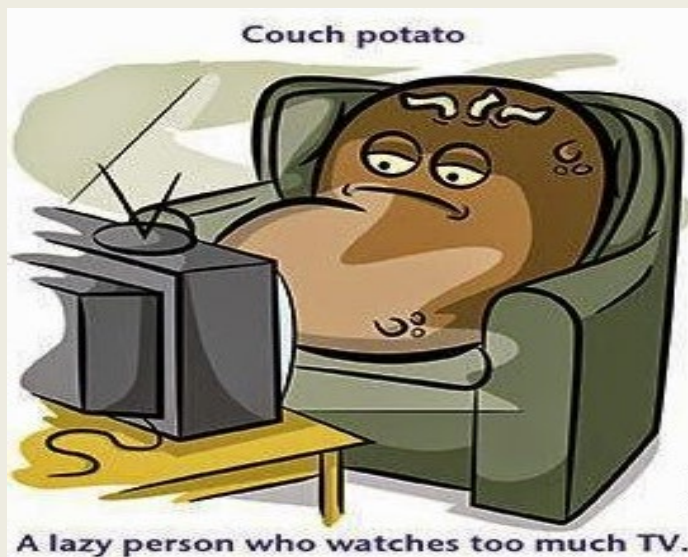
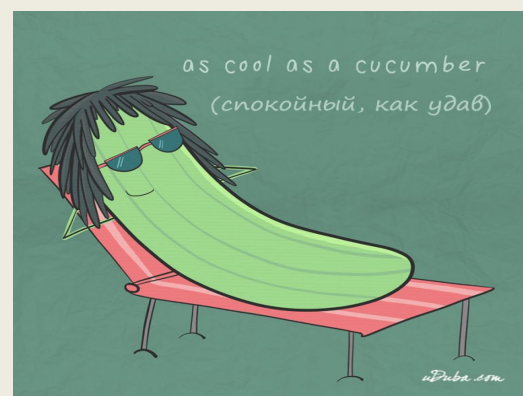
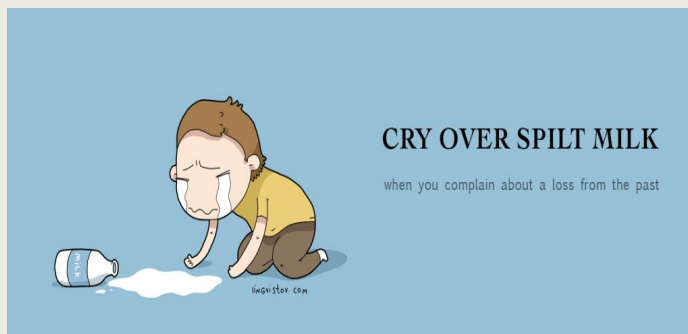
# Saying
